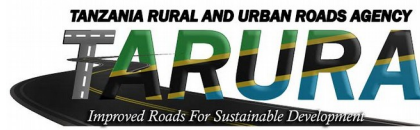

1. This Invitation for Tenders follows the General Procurement Notice which appeared in the Tanzania Procurement Journal of Mwananchi Magazine No. 6291 ISSN 0856 – 7573 dated 18th October, 2017.
2. The Government of Tanzania has set aside funds for the operation of the **Tanzania Rural and Urban Roads Agency (TARURA), Misungwi Council** during the financial year 2016/2017 and 2017/2018. It is intended that part of the proceeds of fund will be used to cover eligible payments under the contracts for **Routine Maintenance, Spot Maintenance and Periodic Maintenance for district road works; and Construction of Concrete Bridge in Misungwi District Council.**
3. The Delegated TARURA Regional Tender Board – Misungwi Council **on behalf of the Chief Executive, TARURA invites sealed tenders from eligible tenderers, registered with Contractors Registration Board (CRB)** in Class as shown in the table below for the following roads:

Tenders will be conducted through the National Competitive Bidding (NCB) procedures specified in the Public Procurement (Goods, Works, Non Consultant Service and Disposal of Public Assets by Tender) Regulations, 2013 – Government Notice No. 446 and are open to National Tenderers only as defined in the Regulations unless otherwise stated in the Tender Data Sheet.

5. Interested eligible and qualified Tenderers may obtain further information from and inspect the Tender Documents at the Office of the Council Manager, TARURA – Misungwi DC, Ujenzi Buildings at Misungwi, P.O. Box 120 – MISUNGWI, Email: cm.misungwide@tarura.go.tz, from 8:00 am to 4:30pm on Monday to Friday except on public holidays.
6. A complete set of Tendering Documents in English and additional sets may be purchased by any interested eligible Tenderer on submission of a written application to the address given under paragraph 5 above and upon payment of non-refundable fee of Tshs. 100,000.00 (One Hundred Thousand Only). Payment **to be deposited in TARURA Misungwi DC NMB bank Account No: 31310008780** and submit the payment evidence from the Bank to Council Manager, TARURA – Misungwi, P.O. Box 120, Misungwi.
7. All tenders must be accompanied by a tender securing declaration in the format provided in the tendering documents.
8. All tenders in one original plus two copies, properly filled in and enclosed in plain envelopes must be delivered to the **Council Manager office, at or before 10:00 hour's local time on 04th December, 2017**. All tenders in enclosed sealed covers must clearly be marked “**TENDER NO. AE/092/2017- 2018/ MSNGDC/W/.....** for (e.g. **Routine, Spot, Periodic Maintenance and Culvert installation works**” on outer envelopes and not be opened before 10:00 am local time on **4th December, 2017**. Bids sent by post must be registered.
Tenders will be opened promptly thereafter in Public and in the presence of Tenderers’ Secretary, TARURA – Regional Tender Board, SLEM Conference Hall at Misungwi, P.O. Box 120 – MISUNGWI, representatives who choose to attend in the opening ceremony at the SLEM Conference Hall, TARURA – Misungwi DC.
9. Late tenders, portion of tenders, electronic tenders, and tender not received, tenders not opened and not read out in public at the tender opening ceremony shall not be accepted for evaluation irrespective of the circumstance.
